Bill Pay Instructions

To set up your billpay account for the first time using the MEMBER REGISTRATION module, it will ask for a **Municipality Code**.

There is a different municipality code for each type of account. The municipality code assures that your payment is applied to the correct bill.

The municipality codes are shown below for each type of bill.

- Metered Water bill municipality code is: Timberon01
- Standby bill municipality code is: TimberonSB01
- FS-1 bill municipality code is: TimberonFS01
- FS-2 bill municipality code is: TimberonFS02
- FS-NS bill municipality code is: TimberonNS01

After that, you will create your own login and password to view and pay your bill.

PLEASE BE AWARE: A separate login must be created for each account and each municipality.

Example: If you have 3 properties, and 3 account numbers, you must create 3 logins in order for the payment to be applied to the correct account.

New Meter Installation

We request that the customer place a marker at the desired meter location on their property. TWSD will provide a marker if needed. The marker should go anywhere along the street line in between the lot boundaries. TWSD will set the meter on the customer's property no more than 15 feet from the point of service (the water line in the street).

Customers must install their own shut-off valve. It should be located on the customer's side of the meter setup. The district's valve between the meter and the street is not for customer use.

Items needed by the customer to complete the meter installation on their side of the meter:

- 1. A 3/4" shut-off valve must be installed on your side of the meter, positive seal, ¼" turn ball valve.
- 2. Outside faucet to hook a water hose to for temporary purposes.
- 3. Schedule 40 3/4" fittings.
- 4. Whatever 3/4" pipe is needed to run a line to the service area as desired.
- 5. Pipe cleaner and pipe glue.

Water Line Extension

3-inch water line extension: \$51.00 per foot.

4-inch water line extension: \$54.00 per foot

8-inch water line extension: \$59.00 per foot

Note: Additional fees may be required due to excessively rocky soil conditions. Prior inspection shall be required.

Standby

A **Standby Charge** of \$61.15 per property each year is charged against non-metered land that has a water distribution line adjacent to it. They are mailed out in December, and are due by March 31st.

This NMPRC approved charge, and Metered Water sales, fund the water system in Timberon. The Timberon Water and Sanitation District maintains/operates approximately 100 miles of distribution lines, five storage tanks, two wells, and a water filtration plant, to supply potable water and fire suppression for the community.

Standby Charges were adopted by the Timberon Water District in 1994.

Facilities & Services

The annual Facilities & Services bills are \$30.00 a lot per year. They are mailed out in July and are due by September 30th.

A Facility and Services Fee of \$30 per property each year, along with a 9.885 mill levy on County Property Taxes, is charged against all properties within the District. This money makes it possible to maintain the approximately 200 miles of roads, providing access to the over 9,000 acres that makes up Timberon. The operation/maintenance of facilities like the Lodge Building and Community Center, Cemetery, Swimming Pool, Playground, BBQ Pavilion, Fishing Lakes, and Golf Course are also funded from this revenue. The costs of services like Trash Disposal and the community Slash Pit, for dumping dead vegetation and trees, are offset by this funding source.

Facilities & Services charges were enacted by the Timberon Water & Sanitation District in 2012.
